

# Gunallo On-Property Sale Report 2011

Cleared 90 Rams to \$2,600 and averaged \$984 (Grossed \$22,000 up on last year)

All apart from 1<sup>st</sup> 8 all were paddock reared.

Very happy with result as we offered more rams for sale and all cleared.

Gained 6 new 1<sup>st</sup> time buyers at On-Property sale.

Top priced ram @ \$2600 was purchased by Bill Walker, Classings Ltd, Murray Bridge for Peter Charlick, Ceduna, SA. The highly rated Poll ram Gun 602 sired by Leahcim 203 carried a 19.4 micron, 2.3 SD, 11.9 CV, 100% CF, and weighing 103 kgs. Runners up was Kym McMahon & Duane Simon, McMahon Bros, Lameroo, SA who went on to purchase 4 to \$1900 (they also purchased 5 rams @ Hamilton Ram sale 2011 to \$2,750)

Bill Walker also purchased another 2 rams for J & M Andre, Millicent, SA, wanting free growing white wools on a large frame.
